This issues with approval of the Rector.

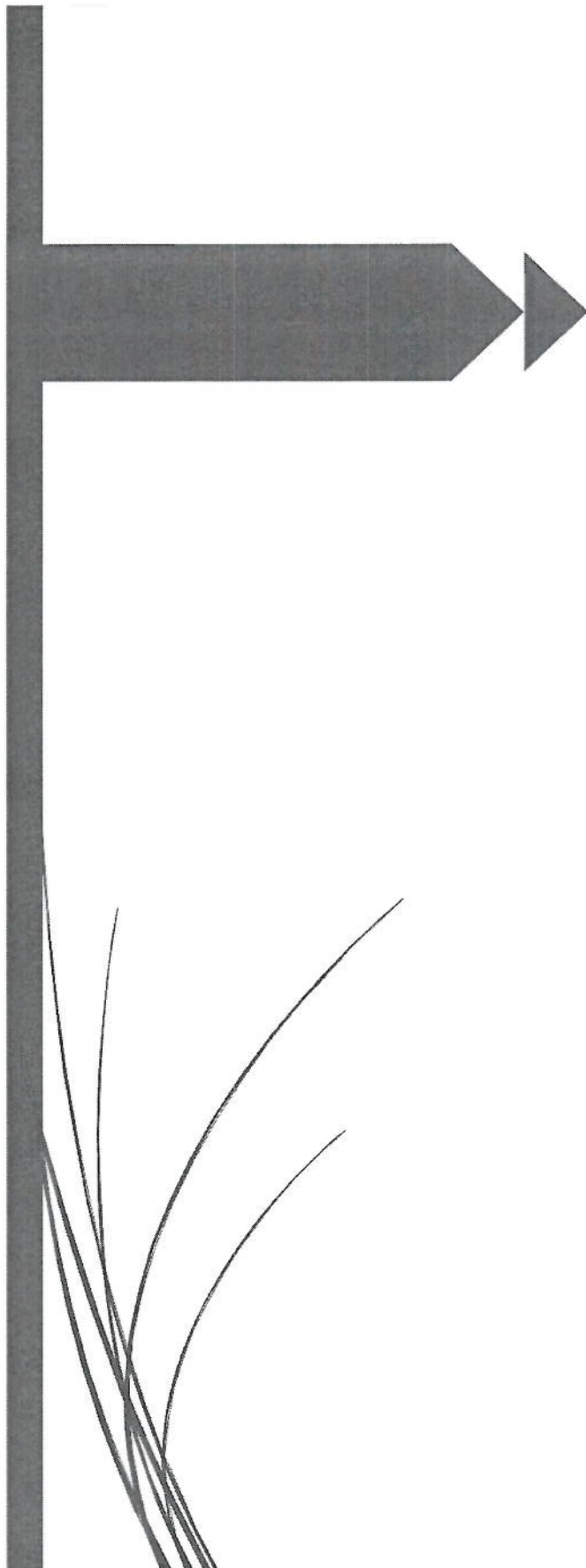

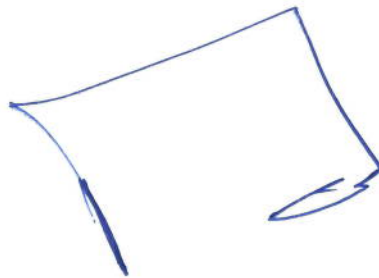

### Admission Policy

---

#### 1. Main Features

Admissions are offered on open merit only (No quota). Namal University does not discriminate based on ethnicity, race, religion, or gender.

The admission schedule is announced on the University website (<https://www.namal.edu.pk/>). The university reserves the right to change the deadlines due to unavoidable circumstances. Any such changes shall also be updated on the website. The candidates are urged to check the website/email to stay informed, periodically.

It is the candidate's responsibility to provide the required and accurate information at the time of application and provide the complete documentary evidence on joining, if admitted.

The admission/scholarship/financial support offer may be cancelled/withdrawn in case of failure to provide the authentic original documents supporting any information provided at the time of application/admission and thereafter.

The admission/scholarship/need cum merit based (financial support) decisions, taken by the University, shall be final.

#### 2. Admission Application and Official Correspondence Mode

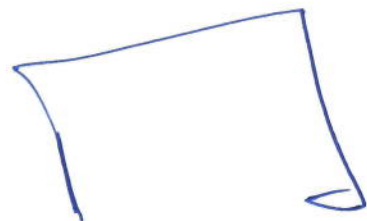
The candidates shall only apply through an online application form available at Namal University's website (<http://admissions.namal.edu.pk>). All official correspondence/admission offer letters shall be made/sent to the candidates through the admission portal and email.

<b>BS Mathematics</b>	1. The following NAT conducted by the NTS NAT (IE or ICS or IGS) Any of the PEC or HEC acceptable Entry Tests

#### 4. Applicants' Eligibility Criteria

- At least 70% marks in intermediate/equivalent exams. The result awaiting candidates shall also be eligible to apply based on HSSC first-year/equivalent exams, who shall be offered a conditional admission offer.
- The confirmation of admission shall be subject to obtaining a minimum of 70% marks in the complete intermediate/equivalent exams, providing the certificate or detailed mark sheet, etc., after the declaration of the result, duly verified by the relevant Board/Board's website.
- Non-matriculation/intermediate stream students must provide an equivalence certificate obtained from IBCC, Pakistan.
- It's the candidate's responsibility to check the eligibility criteria according to the candidate's preferred program.
- The eligibility criteria may be revised/updated, with the approval of the Rector, in light of the requirements of the relevant accreditation bodies.



#### **4.1 Program Wise Academic Qualification Requirement**

<b>Program</b>	<b>Required Qualification</b>
BS Electrical Engineering	As per the minimum criteria prescribed by the relevant accreditation/regulatory body, duly approved by the statutory bodies of Namal University
BS Computer Science	As per the minimum criteria prescribed by the relevant accreditation/regulatory body, duly approved by the statutory bodies of Namal University
Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA)	Intermediate/equivalent
BS Mathematics	Intermediate/equivalent with Mathematics

#### **5. Namal University Aggregate Merit Criteria**

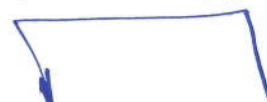
Namal University aggregate merit criteria shall be based as follows.

<b>Program</b>	<b>Qualification/ Entry test</b>	<b>Weightage</b>
BS Electrical Engineering BS Computer Science	Intermediate/ equivalent Exam	50%
BBA BS Mathematics	Entry Test	50%

The aggregate merit shall be worked out as per the aforementioned weightage, using the first-year intermediate/equivalent marks or complete intermediate/equivalent marks, where available. Admission shall be offered on the basis of the first choice. The next choice(s) shall be considered, if needed, after exhausting the first choice in each/particular program up to the minimum acceptable aggregate merit to be decided by the University.

#### **6. Admission Intake**

The shall admit minimum of 160 students, one section of (preferably 40 students) per program.



## 7. Scholarships:

### 7.1 Elite 90 Scholarship (High Achievers):

- 100% tuition fee waiver shall be offered to all candidates having 90% and above marks, using the first-year intermediate/equivalent marks or complete intermediate/equivalent marks, at the time of admission. The Elite 90 Scholarship (High Achievers) are to pay other fees and charges as per university policy.

### 7.2 Need Cum Merit Based Scholarship:

**Scope:** For the applicants at the time of admission, based on Intermediate marks (Part-I/First Year or complete Intermediate – whichever is available at the time of admission).


Intermediate Percentage (at admission)	Upfront Tuition Payable by Applicant	Need-Assessed Scholarship Ceiling*
85.00% - 89.99%	5%	up to 95%
80.00% - 84.99%	10%	up to 90%
75.00% - 79.99%	15%	up to 85%
70.00% - 74.99%	20%	up to 80%

\*The need-assessed portion is determined after a formal need evaluation.

### **Policy Note – Minimum Framework & Namal Scholarship Committee Discretion:**

- The above Need-cum-Merit based scholarship matrix constitutes the maximum, generic framework for awarding scholarships.
- The Namal Scholarship Committee may, at its discretion, increase/decrease the scholarship beyond this baseline after reviewing (i) demonstrated financial need, (ii) departmental priorities and cohort balance, (iii) available funds, and (iv) any other relevant institutional considerations.

### **Eligibility & Process:**

- **Merit basis:** Intermediate percentage as per the above bands (Part-I/First Year or complete result available at admission time).
- 

- **Need basis:** Submission of income/expense proofs and household information for verification as per proforma duly approved by Management Committee as part of Need Cum Merit Based Scholarship policy/guidelines (Scholarships apply to tuition fee).
- False/withheld information will lead to cancellation and recovery of the awarded amount.

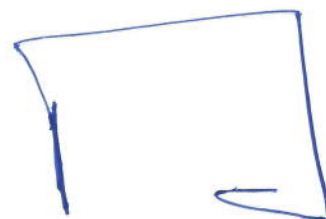
**Note:** Up to 20% of the gross tuition fee revenue shall be generated from the annual admission intake.

### **7.3 Special Incentive(s):**

- Other than the Elite 90 Scholarship (High Achievers) and need-based financial support against tuition fees, applicable to all male and female students, the additional incentives shall be offered as follows:
- 100% Admission fee and Admission Security waiver for candidates belonging to previously called Ex. FATA (currently in KPK) and Baluchistan candidates.
- 100% tuition fee waiver for all candidates having 90% and above marks in intermediate/equivalent exam.
- The students qualifying their Intermediate/equivalent exams (in the current year) from Daanish Schools shall be eligible for a 100% waiver of dues (tuition fee, admission, hostel and exam & lab fee), funded from Punjab Educational Endowment Fund (PEEF). Accordingly, their dues shall be adjusted against the PEEF scholarships.
- Ten (10) students qualifying their Intermediate/equivalent exams from AKHUWAT and fulfilling admission eligibility requirements of Namal University shall be eligible for a 100% waiver of dues (admission, hostel and exam & lab fee). Accordingly, their dues shall be adjusted against the fund sponsored by the AKHUWAT.

### **7.4 Duration:**

The scholarships/financial support shall continue for four years, subject to prescribed conditions as per para 7.5.2.



## 7.5 Tuition Fee, and Other Dues:

\* If the recipient shall be imposed with a penalty under disciplinary proceedings by the Students Disciplinary Committee with recommendations of the cancellation of scholarship as well and his/her appeal (if filed) is rejected by the Appellate Committee, his/her scholarship shall be discontinued as per rules

## 8. Terms and Conditions:

1. The admission policy is applicable to the academic year 2026-27 only, i.e., admissions of the Fall 2026 Semester.
2. The tuition fee and other fees/charges are applicable to the academic year 2026-27 only and may change in subsequent years as per university policy.
3. The university reserves the right to withdraw any scholarships, incentives and/or financial aid at its discretion.
4. The provisional admission offer/confirmation shall be offered in descending order of the aggregate (Elite 90 Scholarship (High Achievers) and Need Cum Merit Based Scholarship).
5. The candidates must inform the University if they secure any external funding for their studies, which shall be paid to Namal University and adjusted towards their Namal scholarship. The university shall compensate such students as per available resources.
6. If a student's financial position changes during his/her undergraduate program, he/she is expected to inform the University for review of their financial need or vice visa. However, the review applications shall only be entertained as per criteria outlined in Need Cum Merit Based Scholarship Policy 2026.
7. One student can avail scholarship/financial support for one time and one program only.
8. The Namal Scholarship Committee shall conduct periodic reviews as outlined in Need Cum Merit Based Scholarship Policy 2026 for provision of scholarships to needy students only as per rules.
9. The duration and continuity of any scholarship and/or financial support shall be as per sections 7.5.2
10. The admission letters shall be rechecked and improved, where necessary.
11. All deposited fees including application processing fee, admission fee, admission security, exam & lab fee, hostel fee and security as well as tuition fee are subject to verification by the Treasurer Office Namal University Mianwali.

## 9. Admission Schedule:

The Admission Schedule shall be approved by the Rector, keeping in view the admission schedules of other universities and test schedules of the relevant institutions/bodies.
