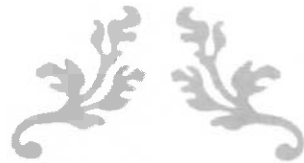

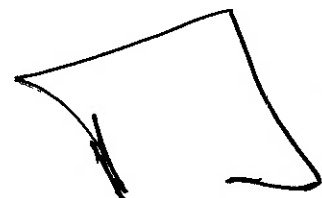
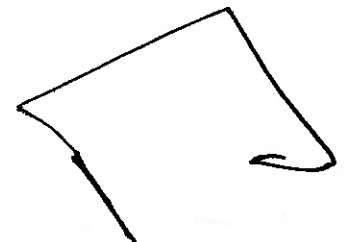

1 Scope:

The policy will be implemented on the campus and the residential area (Chakda) of the university and ensures that all the stakeholders including faculty, management, staff, visitors, contractor, third-party employees or any representative or affiliate, are responsible for the assurance of environmental protection within the defined premises and ensure will to for proper implementation.

2 Objective:

The Environmental Protection Policy, while recognizing the vision and mission of the Namal University Mianwali, proposes conservation strategy, action plan in alignment with national environment related goals. The document also provides a broader guideline for all the stakeholders of the Namal University, Mianwali while addressing environmental concerns and ensuring effective management of environmental resources.

Namal University, in compliance with the National Environment Policy of the Ministry of Environment Government of Pakistan, (Pakistan Environmental Protection Act 1997, National Environmental policy 2005, and National Climate Change Policy 2021) affirms and ensure the protection, conservation and restoration of Pakistan's Environment in order to improve the quality of life of stakeholders and ultimately the society through sustainable development. Namal University affirms and ensures the following statements:

- i. Provide sustainable access to free and safe water supply to all the stakeholders.
- ii. Effectively manage and conserve the water resources by recycling and reusing the water on campus and Chakda.
- iii. Ensure the safe sources of food supplies within the campus and residential area.
- iv. Ensure the food and meals quality according to the national standards along with effective waste control.
- v. Effective reduction and control of harmful emissions in air, noise and other sources.
- vi. Reduce the use of carbon-based fuels and encourage the use of renewable energy sources such as solar systems etc.
- vii. Establish a smoke-free environment in the campus by curbing smoking prevalence, protecting non-smokers from involuntary exposure to second-hand (passive) smoking, and reducing the negative effects of cigarette smoke and littering chemical cladded cigarette ends on the environment. Make sure that campus is a non-smoking area as per HEC policy.
- viii. Promote cleaner production and generation technologies while operating machines and equipment.
- ix. Promote non-motorized means of travel, such as bicycle, walkways etc. within the campus.
- x. Encourage and enforce rules of reduction, recycling and reuse of solid and liquid wastes, especially plastics, polymers and other non-biodegradable products. Promote waste segregation techniques.
- xi. Promote the culture of recycling and reusing the solid and liquid materials.

- xii. Preserve the campus's plantations, and biodiversity within the campus and all regulated sites.
- xiii. Plant sufficient number of trees and plants to promote the greenery and enhance the CO2 consumption.
- xiv. Avoid sourcing and use of hazardous materials within the campus.
- xv. Ensure the dispose-off of hazardous materials produced during the operation of machines or other sources.
- xvi. Ensuring noise free operations and mitigating noise pollution

3 Policy Implementation Actions:

The university leadership aims to encourage environmental protection and achieve benchmark principles at all levels of university operation. In compliance with this policy, the following actions have been taken or are committed to: Installation of water treatment plants in the university complying with the WHO standard.

- i. Installation of water treatment plants and water filters complying with WHO standards. Installation of a water treatment plant ensuring the treatment of grey water (waste water from household sources like showers, bathtubs, and laundry, excluding water from toilets and kitchen sinks).
- ii. Minimize energy resources through the installation of Solar Systems/Green technologies on campus and other sites.
- iii. Plantation of trees to neutralize the carbon footprint (e.g., Namal Eco System Restoration - NER).
- iv. Development of a plastic and paper recycling policy for campus and chagdah. Also promoting plastic free culture on campus.
- v. Enforcing a no-smoking policy in closed environments.
- vi. Maintaining record of recycling and dispose-off of plastics, polymers (fabricated material like chairs, tables etc.) and other non-biodegradable materials within the campus.
- vii. Maintaining Data of plantation within the campus (trees planted, removed, died).
- viii. Budget and other resources will be planned and presented and expense will be reported.

4 Policy Implementation and Follow up Authority

From the office of Rector/Registrar a convener of Environmental Protection Committee of Namal University Mianwali will be nominated under which follow committee will work and report.

- ii. The policy will be reviewed annually for improvement and implementation perspective.
